EDF Nuclear Power Station Visit

I am delighted to inform you that your child has been selected to attend a visit to EDF's Nuclear Power Station in Heysham, Lancashire. This will take place on Tuesday, 31st October 2023. The purpose of this visit is to allow students to gain an understanding of how the concepts they have learned in their Year 9 "Atomic Structure" topic can be applied beyond the classroom.
