Wednesday, 10th June 2026 – Meet the Principal

On Wednesday, 10th June 2025 at 17:00, I would like to invite you and your child to come to the Academy to meet our Senior Leadership Team, Head of Year 7 and I who will be your first point of contact. I will provide all the information you require about how the Academy functions on a day-to-day basis, the uniform that students will be wearing and how you can be involved in your child's secondary education.

Monday, 29th June 2026 - Induction Day for Year 6 Students

Your child will **start at 09:00** and **finish at 14:50**. You are welcome to use the Academy car park to drop off and/or collect your child. There will be several members of staff present to direct the children to where they need to be.

All children will need to:

1. Wear their current school uniform;
2. Bring their PE kit (shorts or jogging bottoms, a t-shirt and trainers will be fine);
3. Bring a notepad, pen, pencil, ruler and eraser;
4. Bring a packed lunch that will last the duration of the day.

Your child will experience a typical day within the Academy. They will remain with their tutor group and spend some time doing tutor based activities to start the process of developing relationships. They will have a mix of academic and practical subjects on the day. There will be plenty of opportunities during social time to mix with the rest of the Year 6 students from other tutor groups.
