Dear Parent/Carer

As you will be aware schools have been advised to remain open for the foreseeable future. We still have no confirmed links to the Covid-19 virus and will continue as normal until informed otherwise by Public Health England.

The advice currently given is for students to stay at home for 7 days if they have:

- (a) A raised temperature
- (b) A new persistent cough

I would ask that all parents follow this advice carefully. The same rules apply to the staff at the academy. It may be in the future that the academy has to make adaptations to the services it can offer based on staff attendance to school. We will keep you informed of any requirements but please be understanding if the academy has to operate reduced timetables or partial closures. Hopefully this will not be necessary but we have to prepare for any eventualities. We have been advised by the government that any foreign trips should be cancelled therefore the Berlin trip will be reviewed. The Year 7 trip to Keppleway is still expected to occur next week.
