English Literature Theatre Visit – Thursday 3rd October 2024

As your child is studying the GCSE English Literature course, students are being given a special opportunity to visit a theatre to watch a live performance of 'An Inspector Calls' – one of their assessed texts. Students will be able to experience Stephen Daldry's multi-award-winning National Theatre production of the play at the Hippodrome Theatre, Darlington.

The trip will take place on Thursday, 3rd October 2024. Students will travel via coach to the venue leaving the Academy at 11:30 am and returning at approximately 6:30 pm. All students must be in full school uniform and will require a packed lunch/snacks for throughout the day.

If you wish for your child to attend the visit, we ask for students to pay a voluntary contribution of £30.85. This will cover the cost of staffing, travel, and the theatre ticket. Unfortunately, if we do not receive enough voluntary contributions the trip will not be able to go ahead.

This visit is optional, but the performance will provide an invaluable opportunity to deepen and enhance their knowledge of a GCSE text, appreciating the play as it was meant to be performed.

Limited spaces do apply; therefore, seats will be allocated on a first come first served basis. (The Academy must receive your child's permission slip and payment before being allocated a place on the visit). I am sure you will agree that this is an excellent opportunity for your child.
