River Caldew Fieldtrip

To enhance their geographical learning, your child has been selected to take part in a rivers fieldtrip in partnership with Eden Rivers Trust. They will be looking at the river Caldew, and will be discussing river features, hard and soft engineering and how this all links to flooding. The trip will take place on **Wednesday**, **21**st **May 2025**. Students will leave the academy at 10:30am and will be back for lunch time. This is a funded trip, and it is hopefully the first in a series of plans that we must work with the Eden Rivers Trust.

As the trip is a river study students will require the following:

- Activity clothing: light-weight clothes, eg tracksuit, leggings, jumpers, t-shirts etc.
- Wellies, trainers or walking boots that they are prepared to get wet / muddy.
- A warm/waterproof jacket or sun cream depending on the weather as geography students we should be able to read a forecast!

Students can attend school in non-uniform. It must be stressed that it is 'field work' so practical clothing is the best as opposed to 'fashionable' attire.
