## **GCSE Geology Fieldtrip**

As your child is studying GCSE Geology at Morton Academy, all students are required to undertake two days of fieldwork as part of their course. The fieldwork days will give students the opportunity to enhance their learning and personal development of the subject. The trip(s) will take place on Monday, 24<sup>th</sup> June and Tuesday, 25<sup>th</sup> June 2024 (exact timings to be confirmed).

### **Field Studies Council**

Miss Lockley, the Geology teacher will be attending the fieldtrip along with the students; however, the day will be run by staff members of the Field Studies Council. FSC are the leading provider of environmental fieldwork and outdoor learning for school groups, providing fun and educational trips. There is no substitute for first-hand experiences in nature. FSC school trips bring classroom learning to life to develop skills such as resilience and independence, and building relationships with peers.

### Cost

The total cost of the visits is £100, this covers staffing, tuition, and transport for both days. To secure the trip with FSC, a deposit of £25 (non-refundable) will be required and will need to be paid via Parent Pay by Friday, 1<sup>st</sup> December. The remaining balance is required in 3 monthly instalments. The second payment of £25 will be due by Wednesday, 28<sup>th</sup> February, the third payment of £25 by Thursday, 28<sup>th</sup> March, and the final payment of £25 by Monday, 29<sup>th</sup> April 2024. If there is any issue with the payment plan, please don't hesitate to contact me at the academy.

### Itinerary

The itinerary will be as follows, although an updated letter will be sent closer to the visit:

Day 1 (Monday) - Metamorphic aureole day walking from the centre, to include grade mapping. Day 2 (Tuesday) - Eden Valley sedimentary day - Mell Fell conglomerate to include sampling for orientation, Penrith aeolian sandstone to include dip and strike, Armathwaite fluvial sandstone to include logging.

### As the trip will take place outside, students will need:

- A packed lunch and plenty to drink (preferably water), enough to last them throughout the day.
- Activity clothes: Lightweight clothes, eg tracksuit, leggings, jumpers, t-shirts etc. (These clothes may get wet so please, no heavy clothing as it is not appropriate.)
- Appropriate outdoor shoes that your child will be comfortable in for the duration of the day.
- A warm/waterproof jacket or sun cream depending on the weather.
