

Covid-19 Protocols

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student/Staff member reports symptoms to the academy emailing M-Alert. The symptoms must be: a new, continuous cough, a high temperature, a change or loss of sense of smell or taste. 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The student should be sent to the Fishbowl Office. Senior Leader monitoring M-Alert will engage first aid staff to monitor student using PPE and regular hand washing. • The Senior Leader will arrange for the classroom the student has been in to be vacated and cleaned. • No one else in the room needs to go home unless displaying symptoms. 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The student will be sent home with a letter. • They will be advised to get a test with NHS Test and Trace. • The student should self-isolate for 10 days (other household members 14 days). 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Members of the bubbles and associated staff are not required to be sent home or self-isolate unless they develop symptoms. 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Academy will contact the local area community infection control team to notify. • The academy will provide an overview of suspected case(s), symptoms and date of onset. 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Where urgent health protection advice is required out of hours contact 101 and ask for advice. 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Staff member/parent/guardian must immediately inform the academy of the test outcome. 		
<p>Negative and No Longer Symptomatic:</p> <p>Student/Staff can stop self-isolating and return to the academy.</p>	<p>Negative but still displaying symptoms:</p> <p>Student/Staff must complete the ten days of self-isolation from the onset of symptoms.</p>	<p>Positive:</p> <p>The academy will contact Cumbria Tracing Hub and other local NHS services to inform of the positive test.</p>
