Year 7 Kepplewray 2024

Thank you for your interest in your son/ daughter attending our Year 7 residential to Kepplewray this year. I can confirm your son/daughter will be attending Kepplewray Monday, 11th March to Wednesday, 13th March 2024. The details for the trip have now been confirmed and are as follows:

- Students are required to attend school at the normal time of 8.35 am. Students are not to attend 1st lesson and will meet in the Atrium where their registration will be taking place. Once registration has taken place, students will be briefed about the residential. We will then board the coach for us to leave the Academy at 9.00 am prompt.
- Students may bring a light snack and water to have on the coach. They will also require a packed lunch for this day. No fizzy drinks are allowed! If your child receives free school meals, please contact Tracy Roberts at the Academy.
- Students will be placed into groups and will be informed of this prior to the trip. If your child is unsure, please ask them to see Mr Zasadzinski.
- Students will return to the Academy at approximately 3.30 4.00 pm on Wednesday, 13th March. (Please ensure your child is collected from school promptly).
- There is a tuck shop available on site, which students will be able to access on an evening. Therefore, if students wish they may bring monies to spend but we do advise they bring no more than £20.00. All children will be responsible for their own monies.
- If your child needs to take anti-sickness medication, please can you administer it in good time for the outward trip. For the return journey, students should hand any medication to a member of staff with name, details, dosage, and parental signature. If your child requires any medication while on the trip or in an emergency, it is vital the above protocol is followed.

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Please ensure we have up to date contact details, medical and dietary information for your child. Forms have been given to your child, please ensure they are completed and returned to school asap.

Please note: Your child is responsible for their own belongings; this includes mobile phones and any other electronic devices. The Academy will not be held responsible for any damaged or lost belongings. Students who bring any of the above do so at their own risk.
