Message from your Neighbourhood Police Team.

As you will be fully aware England is on lock down until December while the Infection rate and death toll continues to rise due to the Coronavirus Pandemic. While Police want to protect communities and your loved ones, we will be enforcing powers given to us by the Government which **will include fines and the arrest of youths not complying with dispersal notices.**

To help control Coronavirus infection in Carlisle, Police **DO NOT** want youths congregating in the City Centre or in other public spaces. They should be going **directly** to and from School, from home, as set out by the Government.

The Government has stated your child should **only** be allowed out if they are;

- Going to and from School,
- With an adult family member to go shopping for basic necessities,
- Taking daily exercise or have any medical need.

These are difficult times for all of us, but we must prevent the deaths of our loved ones at all costs, Cumbria Police are committed to enforcing the Covid 19 powers to keep your family safe.
