## Morton Academy Sports Day

Our Morton Academy Sports Day will be taking place on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2026.

The day will consist of a number of running, jumping and throwing events on the school field. Pupils will have the opportunity to sign up to some of these events where they will represent their tutor/house teams. If your child signs up for an event, they will be invited to the athletics track at an allocated time throughout the day, then return to their normal lessons. Students who do not sign up to an athletics event will remain in their timetabled lesson.

All pupils will attend the Academy as normal at 8.35am. All children, whether participating or not, should attend in their Morton Academy PE kit or alternatively tops/shorts in the colour of their house (if preferred). These must be appropriate for participating in sport and physical activity within a school setting.

Students will also be expected to wear appropriate non-slip footwear when taking part in events and may also want to bring sunscreen and plenty to drink throughout the day.
